3.  **Daisies – Double** – container, minimum 3 stems
4.  **Daisies – Single** – container, minimum 3 stems
5.  **Geranium** – container, minimum 3 stems
6.  **Hippeastrum** – 1 stem
7.  **Nasturtiums** – container, minimum 3 stems
8.  **Orchid** – any type – 1 stem
9.  **Pansy** (including violas) shown flat – 3 stems
10.  **Rose** - 1 stem hybrid tea
11.  **Rose** – Spray e.g. floribunda – 1 stem
12.  **Roses** – container – minimum of 6 stems
13.  **Salvia** – 3 stems
14.  **Statice** – 3 stems
15.  **Bulb or Corm**, not hippeastrum – 1 stem
16.  **3 stems Different Flower Species** – all same shade
17.  **Multiple flowers** e.g. phlox, dianthus – container
18.  **Rhizome or Tuber** e.g. Heliconia – one stem
19.  **Flower Spike** - e.g. snapdragon, gladioli – one stem
20.  **Spikes** (three stems) same species
21.  **Collection of Flowers** – mixed varieties – container
22.  **Container of Flowers** – one variety – container
23.  **Flower** not specified above – one stem

24.  **Azalea** – 1 cut/stem
25.  **Callistemon** - one flower head

### **RULES for COMPETITION**

1. No entry fees.
2. Entries to all Sections must be received by the due time (see separate Sections)
3. No late entries will be accepted.
4. All exhibits in Sections 1 & 2 must be the property of and be grown by the Exhibitor.
5. All exhibits in Section 4 must have been owned and grown by the Exhibitor for at least three months prior to the Show.
6. Each Exhibitor shall, before staging an exhibit, apply to the Show Secretary for an exhibit card for each exhibit and shall place the appropriate card along side that exhibit before judging commences.
7. Exhibitors in Sections 1 & 2 must use containers provided by the Buderim Garden Club.
8. Exhibitors in all Sections are responsible for the arrangement of their exhibits.
9. All entries must be staged by the due time (see separate Sections).
10. Hall will be closed and Judging will commence at 3.30 p.m. Friday 12<sup>th</sup> September
11. No persons other than the Judges and Stewards to be present during judging, other than at the Chief Steward’s discretion.
12. The Judges may, at their discretion, withhold prizes in any Class where they determine the exhibits to be not up to the standard expected.
13. Exhibits in Sections 1 & 2 will become the property of the Buderim Garden Club and may be sold for the benefit of the Club funds.
14. Exhibits in Section 4 must be shown only in the pots/containers/baskets they are growing in without any additional display container or covering.
15. Professional grower or arranger is defined as a person who earns their living or who derives a significant income from that occupation.
16. Prize Money may be collected from the Show Secretary any time after 10.30 a.m. on the Saturday of the Show.
17. Every care will be taken of exhibits but the Buderim Garden Club will accept no responsibility.
18. No exhibit is to be removed from the show benches until after 4.00 p.m. on Sunday, September 14<sup>th</sup> or until authorised by the Chief Steward or Show Secretary.
19. Sections 1 & 2 Exhibits may be wedged at the neck of the container but staking of the stem above the neck is not permitted.
