The Buderim Safe Committee is still meeting on a monthly basis, focusing on key issues within the 2009 Buderim Safe Action Plan. Initiatives developed within this plan are gradually becoming a reality.

The Courtesy Program aimed at drivers passing through Buderim is about to be implemented:-

- there is now an emergency entry/exit to the school grounds which has been re-established by Council with relevant signage in place
- the TV security system for the school oval should be in place for mid year school holidays
- the Council is putting in place a rubbish collection system to improve litter around and near the oval
- the walk to school program is now well established and signs of traffic problems decreasing at that time of the day are evident.

10 Ways to a Better Neighbourhood CRIME - ARE YOU MAKING IT EASY?

- Get to know your neighbours.
- Encourage interaction and a sense of responsibility between neighbours and communities.
- Tell reliable neighbours when you are going away.
- Ask neighbours or friends to collect mail/newspapers and look after the bin whilst you are away.
- Ask neighbours to contact police or Crime Stoppers immediately if they see anything suspicious around your residence.
- Make your house look occupied when you are away - timers for lights/radios and yard maintained.
- Ask neighbours to park their car in your driveway occasionally when you are away.
- Keep an eye on public facilities such as public telephones, schools, park equipment and bus shelters - report the activities of vandals.
- Improve your household security and personal safety which will contribute to overall neighbourhood safety.
- Consider joining a Neighbourhood Watch in your area.
