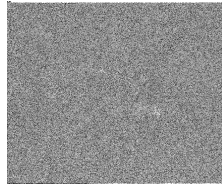

## AREA CO-ORDINATOR REPORT

Hello! And a very Happy 2012 to you all! Hope everyone had a lovely Christmas and a safe and relaxing holiday.

As I write this, on Australia Day, the weather has cleared momentarily, giving us a welcome break from all the rain and wind we've been subjected to over the last couple of weeks. Our wonderful Australia Day Parade here in Buderim had to be cancelled which is very sad, especially as it is our 150th Anniversary this year.

But there will be lots of other things going on in the village over the next year, so keep an eye out in the local paper and on the village website.

At our last NHW meeting we were lucky enough to have one of our local Buderim Beat officers, Snr Constable Sandy Atkinson, come in with a Drink Rite demonstration. The object was to educate us as to how much we are all affected by alcohol and what effects different types, strengths and quantities have on men and women. I think that everyone at the meeting will agree that it was an eye opener!! There was wine, light beer and heavy beer to test out. Unfortunately we only had 2 volunteers (where were the rest of you?), so only the wine and light beer were put to the test.

We started out being breathalysed before having a drink, and having our reaction time tested. Very happy to report both of us had a 0 reading and excellent reaction times! I started off with a standard drink of wine...and a Standard Unit for wine is ONLY 100mls!! Please measure that out at home and put it in the wine glass you normally drink from and I guarantee you will be very shocked at the difference between what you thought was a standard glass of wine and what actually IS! David, our other guinea pig started drinking from a bottle of light beer...it is easier to know what you're drinking if you have beer or cider, as the actual standard drink measurement is on the bottle or can.

In total over the hour, David didn't register at all with the light beer, and I had 3 Standard glasses of wine, only 300mls...which is possibly what we might consume in one glass at a restaurant or at home! My reading was 0.053! And my reaction time considerably slower than that at the start. So I would have been over the limit which is a very scary thought.

It was a very enlightening demonstration and reaffirmed why I personally don't have a drink if I'm driving, because you just never know... Thank you very much to Sandy and Ricky (who gave us a lift home afterwards.) Tongues started wagging in our street when a few neighbours saw me coming home in a Police car!!

## Crime Statistics from our local Police Beat.

### November

- On the 18<sup>th</sup> of December 2011 at 10.50pm a vehicle parked at the Buderim Marketplace was entered and property stolen a short time later Police apprehended and charged a 28 year old male with the offence and some property was recovered.
