Phoning 112 on a mobile connects you to the emergency number anywhere in the world. So you don't have to know 999 for UK, 911 for USA etc. Why do we use 000 ? Because in the olden days zero was beside the finger stop on the rotary dial. So you could find it in the dark.

### **The 50km/h local street speed limit**

was one of the most important road safety developments in Queensland in recent years and the single most significant change of state traffic law since the introduction of drink driving laws. Queensland was the first state or territory in Australia to implement the 50km/h local limit on such a broad scale.

If you notice any vehicle travelling at high speeds in a residential area you can call Policelink on 134 666.

### **Walking home alone ?**

To have an app called "panicguard" on your mobile phone is essential and may save your life. If you feel threatened, shake the phone vigorously. This will set off a high pitched panic alarm. The phone will start flashing and it will activate the GPS so police know where to track you. Panicguard is the only app to receive Police Preferred Specification endorsement. This information was obtained from a reliable web site, but your editor has not tried it.


